WB2EU discussion on EU enlargement in the Western Balkans on Thursday in Berlin

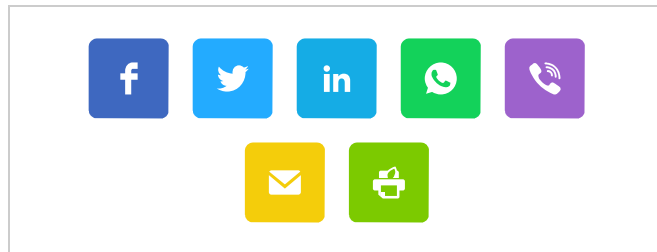

BERLIN – “Western Balkans to EU” Network (WB2EU) will organize a new discussion on enlargement politics, Under the title *“Towards a credible EU Enlargement Policy? What does German “Zeitenwende” mean for the Western Balkans?”*. The event will extend the current discussion on EU enlargement policy in the Western Balkans to the broad public in Germany.

The debate will focus on the question to what extent the “Zeitenwende” proclaimed by Chancellor Scholz after Russia’s invasion of Ukraine has an impact on the EU’s enlargement policy in the Western Balkans. It will furthermore offer the opportunity to get first-hand insights on

the current developments in the region.
